I am Happy to present the Annual Report for the year 2021-22, and share with you the immense progress and development of SAADHYA during this period.

While we were battling with one of the deadliest viruses in the world, scrambling to create order and learning from the chaos around us, we are also trying our best to protect those who are typically left out of relief efforts. The cracks in, and often the absence of, protection of people with disabilities has widened considerably. We at Saadhya are trying to create that bridge so that people with disabilities are able to live a life of dignity, with access to medicines, food, and support systems. Our team have swung into action, and are engaged in providing support wherever it is needed.

Our zeal & aspiration to be a process driven, compliant organization was successfully achieved this year through Organizational Development programme Nirantara 2.0 driven by Dhwani Foundation, where our organization was trained in the areas of Compliance, Governance, finance &accounts, MIS, HR, Marketing and Fund raising, Leadership strategy and Program Management with a score of 94.68% where we achieved 100% in finance management and transparency.

With the support of RISE Against Hunger India and individual donars we could feed 2500 afternoon meals and 270 ration kits during covid lockdown period.

With the support of DNA (Disability NGO Alliance) could support 14000 caregiver and differently abled with two jabs of covid vaccination in Ballari and Vijayanagar district.

We at Saadhya aspire to provide Early Intervention, the highest quality of Special Education, training in Special Olympics Sports and Vocational Training to the Differently Abled Children who come with any form of intellectual disabilities.

I take this opportunity to thank our generous donars, doctors, grassroots-level Partner NGO and well-wishers, who play a crucial role in furthering our mission. Driven by a passionate & self-motivated team, we aim to improve the social status of 2000 mentally challenged persons by 2030. With our innovative programs in Special Education, therapies, art & culture, sports and vocational training, we facilitate inclusion & rainstream employment.

Saadhya Residential School & Vocational Training Centre for Specially Abled Hassan & Hosapete

The school caters to the Special needs of the children with Intellectual Disability, Autism, Down syndrome & Cerebral Palsy with Intellectual

Disability. Our team members and staff are trained in Special Education and vocational training. The school is having disabled friendly infrastructure. We are not only focusing on special education, rather we also train children for Special Olympics.





Impart Vocational training etc. We have specialized team in Special Education, Counselling, Physiotherapy, Sports training. New ideas and approaches, including art, music, and Yoga are integrated within the curriculum.

Early Intervention:

Children below the age of 0 to 8 years are identified at community level, educating the parents on aids and appliances required, school readiness program, Speech, Physio and occupational therapy.





Training the parents in basic life skills, gross motor and fine motor activities. 35 children are undergoing the Early intervention program.

Livelihood Program:

Children are trainied in, Computer program from Amba, Weaving, candle making, paper bags, festival-based items like Diya, Rakhi, Beads hara. 20 children are undergoing these trainings.



Physiotherapy Centre:

Full time physiotherapy unit is set up to provide therapy to children who are in need. There are 35 children undergoing therapy regularly at our centre.



Special Olympics Sports:

Our children are trained in Special Olympics sports like roller skating, athletics, powerlifting, Bocce, Cycling, atheletics, football, basketball.5 children represented at virtual Special Olympics sports, dance sports and Yoga competition.



Covid-19 Relief Work

In the last 1.5 years, COVID-19 impacted us all in more ways than we can imagine. It has given us a new perspective on working towards the betterment of society – by helping people and animals who have no means to support themselves. We, at Saadhya, believe that it's our responsibility, as humans, to help other people/animals by contributing towards their overall wellbeing – both by donating basic resources and by providing mental health support to those who need it.

How has Saadhya Helped

The lockdown due to the pandemic limited the spread of the COVID-19 virus in India. While it did so, it simultaneously reduced the opportunities for people to further grow businesses, daily-wage workers to continue or obtain new work, and it created hardships for underprivileged and disabled people of our society. Not only did it affect humans, but it also affected stray/wild animals.

Dry Ration kits

During the lockdown, we distributed 286 Dry Ration Kits worth Rs.1500/-each to 70 families of Intellectually challenged children, 106 families of the physically challenged children.





35 transgenders, 44 families of nomads and 31 other underprivileged families in rural and urban Hosapete with the support of individual donars.

Afternoon Meals at Taluka Hospital Premises

With the support of Individual donors Saadhya had distributed 2500 afternoon meals at Taluka hospital ,Hospate. We distributed 22 days distributed on an average of 100 to 120 meals.





Health Care kits

Additionally, we distributed healthcare kits to the law enforcement team (Police) 2500 masks, sanitizer in the city who, throughout the lockdown, maintained law and order in the city.



Feeding Voiceless Beings

The staff at Saadhya fed animals during the lockdown in Hampi. Hampi, a world heritage site near our center, attracts tourists from all over the world, throughout the year. Tourists feed stray/wild animals, such as dogs, cows and monkeys, in the area. Because of the lockdown, when tourism wasn't operational, animals faced hardships for basic requirements such as food. We fed these animals as a part of our initiative for Voiceless Beings.



Telecounseling For Covid Positive People

Our all staff pitched in to do the telecounseling to the covid positive people. Our staff was trained by a mental health counselling professional from 100 bed Hospital Hosapete. Every day 20 people including our staff, parents, volunteers were calling average 50 people each and asking about their health and issues they are facing. All together we had counselled 6000 people during lockdown. Our intention was to help eliminate the panic associated with obtaining facilities like oxygen beds and ventilators, whilst simultaneously arranging for the availability of these resources. Our team also counselled COVID-19 infected patients – to alleviate their pain and to clear any misinformation that might have been spread in rural areas.

COVID-19 Vaccination Drive For Persons With Disability and the Care Givers.

As soon as the provision for COVID-19 vaccination of persons above 18 years vaccination was announced, vaccinating differently abled became After successful priority. discussions with the Taluka (District) hospital administration and consultation with the District Disabled welfare officer.



We took the initiative to vaccinate two jabs vaccination to 14000 persons with disability and caregivers in Ballari & Vijayanagar District with the support from DNA-Disability NGO Alliance-Karnataka.


