## Letter from Founder & Managing Trustee

Dear friends, We are proud to present our annual report for the year 2022-23.

Another fantastic year for Saadhya. We are providing inhouse special education training for Children with intellectual Developmental Disability (IDDs). The year's focus was on Early intervention, physiotherapy, skill development and providing social security benefits. We've embarked on several programmes that aim to elevate inclusion of children with special needs. We, at Saadhya Special School, have always believe that partnerships can move mountains. We are happy that we were able to bring together several stakeholders in the disability space to make a beginning towards inclusion and acceptance. Our dream to make our physiotherapy unit at Hosapete was fulfilled at Saadhya with the support from Linde Foundation and MSPL Ltd, Hosapete. Our dream of having skill development unit weaving project was supported by DNA (Disability NGO Alliance, where 20 children are learnt to weave shawls, towels etc. Our project BPO unit was supported by Amba for life with 20 laptops and one teacher training which is an eye opener for the parents at Saadhya. Our project advocacy and early intervention is supported by APD with the target of early detection and intervention of 200 children is the ongoing program till December 2024 and so far our team had visited all the Anganwadi's, PHC, CHC, GHC, Mother and child hospital, Gram Panchayat, NGO's, primary schools to identify children between the age of 0 to 8 years with disability. The support from Shahi exports Pvt Ltd, towards Autism centre at Hassan is another corporate joined to support the disability space.



Sports is another area where we work to bring our special to mainstream and inclusion. In collaboration with Special Olympics Bharat and Amity university Noida we are the research partner for young athlete training and research. I am extremely happy to share our 5 students participated at Special Olympics National Games held at Gujarat & Jharkhand in Roller skating, Cycling, athletics and winning silver and bronze medals.

We at Saadhya board had decided to establish well equipped own residential Special School for 250 children with Intellectual disability at Hosapete with latest facilities for physio, speech & occupation therapy, spacious classrooms, dormitory and disabled friendly environment. Hence got leased 18400 sq feet land at Jambunath Road, Hosapete from Hosapete Urban Development Authority. In this building we would like to establish not only latest facilities but also trained personnel, providing good quality, affordable, upto date education & therapy. Hence I seek every one's support for completing the building by April 2025. We have long rued the lack of skilled caregivers and trained manpower to work with people with IDDs. Our advocacy towards this will form part of our future focus. The challenges are many, but we are confident that with your unwavering support, we can reach them.

To many the well-wishers and friends of Saadhya –the donors, philanthropists, entrepreneurs, funding agencies, and individuals who found it in their hearts to offer logistic, human, and financial support to our various programs, we extend our gratitude. We thank the parents and CWSNs of Saadhya for being the inspiration for the young team of professionals to work enthusiastically from the ground.

I take this opportunity to thank our generous donors, doctors, grassroots-level Partner NGO and well-wishers, who play a crucial role in furthering our mission. # Highlights of the year 2023



## Saadhya Special School Hosapete:

In 2022 to 23 academic year the total strength of the school was 154 children with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities, out of which 46 are girls and 108 are boys. There are 62 students in residential care and training and 92 children are day school children. They commute every day to school-by-School transport. For this capacity of children, we are working with the team of 52 staff out of which 22 are special educators and 26 are non-teaching staff. The curriculum followed at Saadhya is FACP, designed by NIMH (National Institute for mentally handicapped Secunderabad) Quarterly Planning is done and IEP is prepared in consultation with parents or the Guardian. Three goals are taken for every quarter and training is done regularly to improve the child. There are drastic improvement seen in the children and the parents seeking for admission is increasing year after year.

This year 515 Parents approached to Saadhya, Hospet center for seeking admission, out of which 181 are children below the age of 10 yrs. Because of the unavailability of the infrastructure, staff and the financial condition we had restricted ourselves to 154 children.

## Physiotherapy Unit



We are happy to share that Linde Foundation had sponsored Saadhya about 5.5 Lakhs rupees worth physiotherapy materials and MSPL Ltd. is sponsoring one full time physiotherapist honorarium. Hence, we are able to provide therapy to 35 children with IDD with physical deformities. There are many success stories, one success story here to reveal is Mariyamma Aila aged 6 years was unable to walk or sit on her own, now she is able to walk without support. There are many such instace where the physiotherapy is working very well with these children

# Skill Development Program

Children above the age of 16 yrs are placed in our prevocational/ skill development programme. Under skill development programme we have programs like weaving, Specific computer literacy programme, preparing festival-based items paper bags ornamental mala etc

## Weaving Project



This project is supported by Enable India & Bosch, implementing partner is DNA (Disability NGO Alliance). In this project 2 craft teachers undergone 5 phase of training at Amogh Trust Bangalore for a period of 5 days in each phase. In return these teachers had trained 16 students of Saadhya. Out of these 7 students are able to weave swals, towels with little support, remaining children are under the training. This project had brought lot of confidence in children, They're sitting tolerance had increased and they are happy that they are able to produce something new and the children started getting lot of appreciation from the visitors

## Specific Computer learning program



This programme is designed by Amba for life , Saadhya is Certified partner of Amba. This program had shown the world that Children with intellectual disability also can work with computers and lead dignified life. 20 children with mild to moderate IDD,s are learning Computer and non-computer activities under this programme. In this programme the curriculum is design in such as way, where more than academic ability, memorising importance is given to the visual ability, matching an object alphabets ,numbers ,colours etc in computer and non-computer activities . Because of this child learn to match and produce the required products with very limited support. As Saadhya achieved the non-computer activites, Amba for life had supported Saadhya with 20 laptops and training module to make these children work with computers and in future become financially independent



## Other products/Festival based items:

Children with severe disabilities are trained in festival-based items like beads hara, candles, rakhee, paper bags etc.

# Special Olympics games

Children above the age of 16 yrs are placed in our prevocational/ skill development programme. Under skill development programme we have programs like weaving, Specific computer literacy programme, preparing festival-based items paper bags ornamental mala etc



Saadhya Focus on overall development of children with IDD, sports is one among them. In the academic year 2020 to 2023, twenty-five children participated in Special Olympics state games out of which five got selected for special Olympics national games like powerlifting, roller skating, athletics held at Gujarat , cycling- held at Jharkhand - Our athletes travelled in flight for the first time while going to various national games. This was an opportunity for a child with intellectual and developmental disability where parents themselves dint had the opportunities to fly. In all the events our athletes performed very well. All our children remained independent in all the areas wherever they travelled and they could cooperate with other coaches leaving their teachers and family members.

## Young athlete program:



Children between the age group 2 to 8 years were trained in young athlete program under special Olympics banner, where Special Olympics provides training for special educators and parents in overall development of child's motor and cognitive development. 35 children from Saadhya are part of young athlete Programme where they are also undergoing a research by Amity University ,Noida an association with special Olympics. The aim of Saadhya is that these children, when they attain the age above eight years they will be absorbed into various special Olympics traditional sports and these athletes will be given opportunity to play at a district, state ,national and international level provided they are competitive in the sports & games

## Registration under National Trust Act Legal Guardianship



Another milestone of Saadhya is registration with National Trust. This had made Saadhya to avail various benefits for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Hence Saadhya got the eligibility for registering for Niramaya insurance scheme and to be a member of national trust local level committee. Now Saadhya is the member organization for Local level committee of Ballari & Vijayanagar district. We also registered 140 children with IDD, s under Niramaya Health Insurance scheme. In return our children could claim worth Rupees 1,54,000.

# Community Intervention

This year we started our intervention at community level, focusing on early detection and intervention so as to address at the early stage of various disability and help them to get necessary service along with the department. Saaadhya also aims to help differently abled population by making them to avail Social Security benefits and aids and appliances

## Early intervention program



In association with APD Bangalore saadhya had launched Early detection and intervention community level program in Hosapete Taluka, Vijayanagar Dist. 3 full time staff working in the field to identify the children with disability. The screening starts from birth to 8 years of age. We are also closely working with Governments RBSK team, Anganwadi, Asha workers. Govt hospitals, GHC, CHC, PHC's, Gram panchayat. In this program we will be screening 4000 children to identify 200 children with disability. So far 80 children with different disability is identified. These children were referred to avail required aids & appliances to bring down their disability level at the young age, helping them to avail social security benefits like UDID Card, Disability pension, Niramaya insurance etc.



## UDID Drive



Another important program saadhya is working at the community level along with the Health department and DNA (Disability NGO Alliance) is UDID drive in Ballari & Vijayanagara district. Here we are helping the persons with disabilities, where they are unable to apply online for UDID card or unable to go for medical check-up, Saadhya team is helping them to avail this facility by taking them to the hospital and guiding them regarding doctors visit, camp dates and physically being there. Through this initiative we could help 162 person's with disability to avail UDID card.

# External Competitions & Events

Children at Saadhya are encouraged to participate in all the external competition to boost their morale and to bring them to mainstream. Here we encourage them in Dance, , Speech, drawing, fancy dress and song competitions. Our children always performed very well and brought laurels to school and their parents

# Saadhya Special School Hassan

In 2022 - 23 academic year the total strength of the school was 52 children with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities, out of which 16 are girls and 36 are boys. There are 13 students in residential care and training and 39 children are day school children. They commute every day to school on their own.

The curriculum followed at Saadhya Hassan is FACP, designed by NIMH (National institute for mentally handicapped Secunderabad) Quarterly Planning is done and IEP is prepared in consultation with parents or the Guardian. Three goals are taken for every quarter and training is done regularly to improve the child. Lot of improvement seen in the children. There are 6 teaching and 7 non teaching staff working at our Hassan center.



## Physiotherapy

Physiotherapists visits Saadhya twice in a week, 13 children undergoing physiotherapy.

## Inclusive activities

Saadhya works towards inclusion to bring our children with special needs to mainstream of the society. As part of this our students participated in Bocce inclusive games with Malnad Hippo Campus school. Also Saadhya students got opportunity to perform dance at their school day.
